Swachh Aadat- a program committed to promote healthier communities; community awareness sessions were conducted focusing on Health and WASH (Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene). These sessions engaged local residents in interactive discussions on personal hygiene, disease prevention, menstrual health, and safe water practices.

1800 participants were encouraged to adopt simple yet impactful daily habits such as handwashing, waste segregation, and the use of clean drinking water.

As part of our continued efforts to promote accessible and preventive healthcare, Global Foundation of Good Neighbors conducted a series of community health camps in Jahangirpuri, Seemapuri, Uttam Nagar, and Rangpuri Pahari.

These camps offered free health check-ups for children, adolescents, women, and elderly residents, along with basic diagnostics, consultations with general physicians, and informative sessions on nutrition, hygiene, and common illnesses—facilitated by local medical professionals.

Beyond addressing immediate health needs, the camps played a crucial role in promoting preventive care and encouraging community members to adopt healthier daily practices, fostering a more aware and health-conscious population.

Good Change for The World

Shuhana threads her way to independence

Shuhana, 21, a young woman from Seemapuri, always dreamt of continuing her education. However, financial constraints and cultural expectations forced her to step away from school after completing class 10th. Her father, a daily wage laborer, earned just Rs. 200–300 per day, which barely covered the family's basic needs.

When Shuhana came to know about the free tailoring course under the SkillEd project, she eagerly joined. With no prior experience, she began learning cutting, stitching, and garment finishing with the support of experienced trainers. Over the next few months, Shuhana not only learned a new skill but also developed a sense of confidence and purpose.

Today, she stitches clothes from home for her neighbors and community members and has started earning a steady income. She supports her family's day-to-day expenses, and she's now saving up to buy her own sewing machine.

"This training gave me something I never thought I'd have — a way to stand on my own feet," Shuhana shares proudly.
