### **Introduction:**

On the 20th of December 2024, the Global Foundation of Good Neighbors, in collaboration with Bharti Eye Hospital, Okhla, organized a free eye check-up camp at SVBP School, Tughlakabad Extension. The camp was held with the primary objective of providing essential eye health screenings for students, teaching staff, and helpers. The focus was on identifying refractive errors and other common eye ailments among the participants. Additionally, the event aimed at raising funds to support children in need of vision correction, particularly those with refractive errors.

### **Purpose and Objectives:**

The free eye check-up camp was organized with several key objectives in mind:

1. **Eye Health Screening:** To provide free, comprehensive eye check-ups to students, teachers, and staff of the SVBP School. The screenings focused on identifying common eye issues, particularly refractive errors such as near-sightedness, farsightedness, and astigmatism.
2. **Raising Awareness:** To promote awareness regarding the importance of eye health and early detection of visual impairments, especially refractive errors, which are prevalent but often undiagnosed in young children.
3. **Fundraising for Children with Refractive Errors:** One of the primary aims of the camp was to raise funds to provide corrective eye treatments (such as eyeglasses) for children who require them. This initiative is particularly focused on

4. **Community Engagement:** To involve the local community, including school staff, helpers, and parents, in supporting the cause and participating in the camp.

#### **Camp Details:**

- **Total Number of Students Screened:** 288 students from SVBP School participated in the eye check-up camp. These students were screened for refractive errors and other common eye conditions that may affect their vision and overall well-being.
- **Additional Participants:** The camp also saw active participation from the teaching staff and school helpers. They were invited to undergo eye check-ups and screenings, reinforcing the message that eye health is essential for everyone, regardless of age or role.
- **Duration of the Camp:** The camp was conducted from 11:00 AM to 5:00 PM, ensuring ample time for all participants to receive a thorough examination. The process was organized efficiently, with several doctors and optometrists working simultaneously to accommodate the high volume of screenings.

#### **Services Provided:**

- **Comprehensive Eye Check-Up:** Each participant underwent a full eye examination, which included vision tests for refractive errors such as myopia (near-sightedness), hyperopia (farsightedness), and astigmatism. The tests were conducted using modern diagnostic equipment to ensure accuracy.
- **Screening for Other Eye Conditions:** In addition to refractive error assessments, other common eye conditions such as conjunctivitis, dry eyes, and eye infections were also checked. Participants who required further medical attention were referred to Bharti Eye Hospital for follow-up treatment.
- **Eyeglass Distribution (if applicable):** For students found to have refractive errors, the necessary arrangements were made to provide



them with eyeglasses, funded

through the funds raised during the camp.

- Eye Care Education: Participants were provided with educational materials on the importance of maintaining good eye health, tips for reducing eye strain, and when to seek medical help for eye problems.

### Fundraising for Children with Refractive Errors:

The event will serve as a fundraising platform to support children with refractive errors who do not have access to corrective measures due to financial constraints. The funds raised during the camp will go towards:

- Providing Eyeglasses: A significant portion of the funds will be used to distribute eyeglasses to students diagnosed with refractive errors, ensuring they can see clearly and perform better academically.
- Awareness and Outreach Programs: Additional funds will be allocated to future eye care camps and programs aimed at reaching more children in need, particularly in underserved communities.

### Camp Highlights:

- High Participation Rate: The camp successfully screened 288 students, along with numerous school staff and helpers. This high participation rate underscores the community's enthusiasm for improving eye health and addressing vision issues.
- Efficient Organization: The camp was well-organized, with multiple eye care professionals on-site to ensure that all participants received timely and accurate screenings. The Bharti Eye Hospital team coordinated with school staff to ensure smooth flow throughout the event. Community Involvement: The event not only benefited the participants directly but also fostered a sense of community involvement. Parents, school staff, and local community members contributed generously to the fundraising efforts, demonstrating their support for the cause.

### Outcome and Impact:

The free eye check-up camp was a resounding success. 23 students were diagnosed with refractive errors, while SOME Received referrals for follow-up treatment. The camp helped
